

Serial Prescription

Your doctor has issued you with a Serial Prescription

This is because you have registered for the **chronic medication service** with your pharmacy.

The prescription will last either 24, 48 or 56 weeks and means that **you do not need to reorder the medication on the serial prescription** as your pharmacy will have the prescription already and will prepare it when you need it, or earlier if you are going on holiday for example and let them know.

Some of your medication might not be included on your serial prescription. There is a chart on the back of this leaflet, advising you which medication is on your serial prescription and what is not.

If an item has not been included on your serial prescription you will still need to reorder this **from your GP Practice** when you require it.

If any of the medication on your serial prescription changes or is stopped, your doctor can cancel the prescription and issue a new one.

Please also inform your pharmacy of any changes made to your medication.

You are only able to collect your serial prescription from your registered pharmacy where you have signed up.

You are encouraged to use the same pharmacy for your other prescriptions so as to keep a consistent record of your medicines.
